Attendance FAQ

1. What time is my student considered late?

- Students must be in their seats by 7:45am. Students who come into the building after this time will receive a tardy.

2. How many Tardies will my student be allowed to have?

- We encourage your students to be on time to class every day. Each minute missed of class is a missed opportunity to learn. Excessive tardies will result in a lunch detention.
 - i. 5 tardies (7:45am) = Lunch Detention
 - ii. 5 Tardies to class (Upper School) = After-School Detention

3. When should I schedule doctor/dentist appointments?

- Schedule any appointments before or after the 9:25am Official Attendance Taking Time so your student is counted present.

4. What should I do if my student will be absent for the day?

5. Should I provide a doctor's note?

- Yes. Always bring a doctor's note for medical appointments or any appointments attended while your student was out sick.

6. How many excused absences can my student have without being penalized?

Due to voiced concerns from families, the Great Hearts Texas District has changed the attendance policy for the 22-23 school year. This year, your student will be allotted *9 "parent excused sick days"* without a doctor's note. It will be your responsibility to contact the school to report a sick day. Once the 9 excused sick days have been used, any sick days after will be considered unexcused. If you do not contact the school, it will be considered an unexcused absence. *Any illnesses due to Covid will not be included in this type of absence*
