January 3-5 Presentations on January 6, 2023 Instructions

Students will all be assigned an animal from one of the seven continents and create a report, visual representation, and short presentation.

- Students will need to complete the attached report by using a nonfiction book or reliable online source that provides adequate information about their animal. The more information you gather, the better prepared you will be to complete your report!
- Students will make a creative visual of the information recorded. The visual must include the animal, its habitat, and continent. (A poster, diorama, mobile, model, etc.)
- Students will prepare and memorize a verbal presentation to share with their classmates covering all components of the report. The speech should be 2-5 minutes in length.
- This project will count towards next quarter's history and science grade and should be completed with much care.
